I had several TDY missions in Vietnam beginning in 1967 and ending with an in-country tour when I was injured in 1974. I flew as a Master Navigator on C-141s with soldiers and cargo from McChord AFB to Vietnam and wounded and remains on return flights from 1967 until 1969. I flew WC-130s on 99 Typhoon penetration missions from Guam and rainmaking missions in Laos from 1969 until 1973, and EC-47 Electronic Warfare missions from Nakhon Phanom RTAFB in 1973 and 1974. During this time I flew 740 combat hours and I was awarded 11 Air Medals and the Distinguished Flying Cross.
